

ASES REGISTRATION

Fair Oaks Elementary

About: The ASES after school program is a grant funded program available at no cost to eligible students in grades K-6*. The ASES program is aligned with the regular school day and includes academic support and enrichment activities.

*A gap program is not available from the time that AM kindergarten students are released to the time the after school program begins.

Eligibility: Recent legislation (AB 130) established priority enrollment rules for the ASES program:

- First priority: identified foster or homeless youth
- Second priority: students eligible for free or reduced priced meals
 - families will need to complete the OJUSD meal application
- After the priority window closes and if space allows, students on the waitlist will be invited to participate.

The registration window for priority students
opens **AUGUST 30** and closes **SEPTEMBER 24**
